PRESENTATION OF BIDS FOR THE ATHENS CITY SCHOOLS SCHOOL BUILDING PROJECT

Mr. Robert Greene, Director of Schools, gave a brief presentation on the new PreK-5 school along with renderings of the project. He provided a bid tabulation of the five bidders of record (The Christman Company, Johnson & Gaylon, Inc., Merit Construction, Inc., Path Construction NE, Inc., and Wilson Construction Group.) After a careful review of the bids, Mr. Greene recommended approval of Merit Construction, Inc. The base bid was \$36,240,000 less alternates and allowances, and including a \$1,500,000 contingency, the total bid was \$30,516,449.
