## Veterans Memorial Park COMMEMORATIVE BRICK & BENCH PROGRAM

On September 2, 2000, the City of Athens, TN officially dedicated Veterans Memorial Park in honor and memory of veterans of the armed services. During the park dedication, Neal Ensminger, in his remarks said, "From this point forward, this will be higher ground." True to his words the Park has become a special place for veterans and their families. Home to an awe-inspiring brick walk with the names of thousands of veterans etched into individual bricks, the park also includes monuments, black granite benches and a court of flags that surround the park centerpiece, a six hundred pound floating granite globe.

Bricks may be purchased at any time for \$50 per brick. When purchasing your brick, you may also choose to purchase a 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 3" replica take-home brick for \$20 per brick. You may also have your replica shipped to you for an additional \$10 fee or delivered to Athens City Hall for pickup. In addition to a brick being placed in the walkway, brick purchasers receive an attractive certificate suitable for framing.

If you are interested in purchasing a granite bench please contact the Parks and Recreation office for details. Each brick placed on the walkway and each replica, will be laser engraved with the name and branch of service of the honored veteran.
